How much play should there be in the front wheel bearings Jun 8, 2008 — Is this the acceptable method for testing wheel bearing play? If there should be no play, I will re-adjust the bearings as described. I used the Wheel Bearings 101 - Brake & Front End One way to check wheel-bearing play is to raise the wheels off the ground and rock the tires in and out while watching for any looseness. As a rule, there should be no play on most FWD cars, but up to .010 inch of play in the front bearings may be acceptable on RWD cars and trucks with adjustable bearings
